The project.

In its first week of trading, more than one million shoppers visited the new extension to St David's Shopping Centre in Cardiff. With more than 100,000 square metres of brand new retail space, the centre is home to many iconic brands including Apple, Hugo Boss, LK Bennett and Kurt Geiger.

Designed by Benoy, the development has rejuvenated the existing St David's Arcade and has created a new landmark retail centre in the heart of the city.

The challenge.

Venesta was approached by Benoy Architect, Maria Cannovina, who was looking for a contemporary, streamlined washroom solution to complement the Centre's modern aesthetic.

Durable toilet cubicles were required to withstand the demands of such a high footfall shopping centre. As well as toilet cubicles, St David's Shopping Centre also had a requirement for IPS (Vepps) and vanity units.

The solution.
